1. Stormwater grant – Opened to public for speaking. Public comments made. Discussion of issues with water and damages that have happened to homes in the community. The town needs help getting this fixed. Discussion of debris and how it collects all the way through town in various spots. Where do we stand on the grant and why did it fail the last time. Application goes in 7/20/18. Find out of award in August. Discussion on east side of town where water comes into town. Discussion on rate for stormwater and grant money and other funding the town is looking for. Stormwater board has done some smaller projects over the years, but there hasn't been enough funding to get major project work done. We have issues – we need help getting it done. Discussion on safety aspect as well. It is causing hazards on roadways as well as homes. People needed to be rescued from their home and from their vehicle. Discussion on past history of town of waterways and what has been done to help get water through town. There will be no way to stop the water coming. November of 2017 and February and April 2018 of this year has caused two homes to be condemned. Discussion on flood plain area. Community needs to come together to do all we can to get grants and work on fixing the problems. Discussion of stagnant water causes health hazards as well. Also the issues of CSO's (Combined Sewer Overflow) from all the water issues. Final comments by council.
