## Department Reports

1. Building Commissioner— (Kates) see report.Report given. Casey's construction moving forward. Looking at 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> week of December for opening. Looking at trends since 2005 – it is moving forward. In 2000, there was a stormwater board made and building information has changed. Studies show that retention ponds need to be in the county to help with the water runoff during large storms.

2. Police Department - (Buchholz) see report. Report given. Lost a police car during the storm on 11/5. Waiting on adjuster for insurance information. New truck should be up and running soon. Waiting on radio. Food drive was a success. Raised about \$1,400. Plans this Thursday to deliver approx 50 families with the Fire Dept. Hopefully the same if not more for Christmas. Had officer Thackrey resign from the

department.

3. Fire Department - (Spears) - see report. Report given. Assisting with the holiday food drive. Volunteers would be appreciated. Annual Christmas party December 10<sup>th</sup>. Two candidates going to training process. Due to complete some time in Jan 2018. Turkey Chase is this weekend, volunteers would be appreciated. Worked side by side with Utility and police departments during the storm on 11/5/17. Chief Spears and G. Hill is looking at pre-specs of new fire engine.

4. <u>Utility Manager</u> (Hines) - see reports.Reports given.Had to take some stop signs down and a rock and some bushes at 4th & Walnutstreet due to a semi trying to go

down small street. If there is a non emergency - please call 855-5222.

a. Street-see report. Working on trying to get leaves picked up. Had some issues with truck that pulled the leaf vac. Have plenty of salt on hand. Gary has been working on getting snow blades ready for trucks.

b. Water - see report. Everything is good. Heat is checked and working well.

c. Wastewater/Stormwater- see report. 7 CSO's this year to date.CSO prelim engineering plans done. Mtg scheduled for Dec. 7<sup>th</sup>.

d. Electric - see report. Had a power outage on 11/10/17 that was caused by a squirrel. Got 4 fuses on 4 poles. IMPA/ISC was called in and got the issue taken care of quickly.
