ORDINANCE NO. 2022-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF CENTERVILLE, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Town of Centerville, Indiana ("Town") had historically been divided into five (5) districts for the purpose of electing Town Council members ("Council District(s)"),

WHEREAS, since the last time the Town certified the map and description of its election districts, the Town has annexed new area, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council shall now consequently reestablish and certify the Town Council Districts in accordance with Indiana law.

BE IT ORDAINED in a duly held public meeting by the Town Council (the "Town Council") of the Town of Centerville, Wayne County, Indiana:

SECTION I: The five (5) Council Districts for the Town of Centerville are hereby stated and established, as set forth in the map attached hereto as Exhibit A, which map is incorporated herein by reference, which Council Districts shall be identified as "Wards".

SECTION II: The above Section I of this ordinance shall be a restatement of Chapter 30 of the Code of the Town of Centerville, Indiana, Section 30.06, subsection (B), effective upon adoption. All other existing subsections of Chapter 30, Section 30.06, namely subsections (A)(1), (A)(2), (C), and (D) as ordained on September 17, 2018 shall remain in full force and affect.

SECTION III: The Council hereby certifies that the Districts as drawn in this ordinance comply with Indiana Code § 36-5-2-4.1.

SECTION IV: The Town Clerk-Treasurer and/or Town Attorney shall forward a signed copy of this Ordinance to the Wayne County Circuit Court Clerk, along with a copy of Exhibit A, not later than thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION V: This Ordinance, with its attachment, shall be put on file with the Town Clerk-Treasurer for public inspection.

<u>SECTION VI.</u> The sections, subsections, paragraphs, references, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable. If any phrase, clause, reference, paragraph, subsections and sections of the Ordinance are declared unconstitutional, invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION VII. That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force and effect, from and after its passage and adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Centerville. Wayne County, Indiana, and upon the signature of President of the Town Council therefore










Detail Poplar Ave
